Strengths

Offense: Naturally gifted scorer... Absolutely punishes less athletic defenders in the post... Great touch on hook shots over the left shoulder... Shoots 45% from both midrange and 3 off the catch... Dangerous operating out of the high post... Quick and accurate passer out of double teams... 97th percentile scoring in transition... Improving vision in open court... Great first step... Gets to the rim quickly on straight line drives.

Defense: Exciting combination of length and quickness... Guarded the 2 through the 5 in college, very versatile... Uses length to protect rim... Denies the post hard... Really crashes the glass.

Weaknesses

Offense: Turnover prone... Can force passes that aren't there... Handle isn't very advanced right now... Not breaking defenders down off the bounce... Needs to get more comfortable on the perimeter where he will do most of his work at the next level.

Defense: Doesn't always enforce his will on the game... Conserves energy for offense sometimes... Leaves his feet quite a bit around the rim.

Intangibles

Goodman is an absolute gym rat. Already an elite division II player that is still eager to improve and add dimensions to his game. Has improved as a vocal leader on the court as the season's progressed. Willing to do the little things on the court that benefit the team. Far from selfish despite being the nexus of Westminster's offense. He appears to have a very quirky personality that teammates enjoy.
